“Our wings are incredible and available in a variety of sauces, including teriyaki, mild Mexican and Buffalo hot,” said Justin. “An added bonus is our Sunday wing special of 50-cent wings — a perfect complement to cheering on your favorite team.”

For families wanting to bring the kids without the expense, kids eat free every Tuesday. Families and couples also enjoy Elsa's “2 for \$20” menu, which includes one appetizer, two entrées and one delicious dessert. Best of all, “2 for \$20” is available every day, all day long.

“The portions on our “2 for \$20” menu are so generous that guests frequently ask for take-home boxes,” said Justin. “In addition to a shared appetizer and dessert, each entree includes Mexican rice and refried beans. It really is a heck of a deal.”

Elsa's is in the heart of downtown Lutz at U.S. 41 and Sunset Boulevard in a strip center behind McDonald's. Located four miles south of State Road 54 and four miles north of Bearss Avenue, its patrons mostly come from Lutz, Land O' Lakes, Wesley Chapel and north Tampa.
